DISCUSSION AND ACTION – Air Quality/Health Concerns involving Pattison Sand and Gravel Operations (NOTE: At its January 3rd meeting, the Common Council directed the issues of air quality and noise concerns, involving the Pattison Sand and Gravel operations along the Highway 18 bypass, to the Committee for further discussion.)
5. DISCUSSION AND ACTION – Ordinances involving Nuisances, Property Maintenance and General Appearance (NOTE: At its October 27th meeting, Mayor Hemmer asked the Committee to review the city's current ordinances on nuisances, property maintenance and general appearance and make recommendations on changes, if needed.
