MEETING NOTICE – PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE **Tuesday May 29th 2012 – 6:00 P.M. – Conference Room #2 – City Hall**

ITEMS TO BE DISCUSSED AND ACTED UPON:

1. Call to order/Roll Call
2. Certification of the open meeting law agenda requirements and approval of the agenda
3. APPROVAL – Minutes of the May 16th 2012 meeting
4. DISCUSSION AND ACTION – Wells Street Sidewalk Project (NOTE: On May 15th, the Council sent this item back to the Committee for further discussion.)
5. DISCUSSION AND ACTION – Proposed Changes to the No-Parking on Fremont Street between Wells and Taylor (NOTE: At the May 16th Committee meeting, Chairman Riebe proposed the no-parking zone on Fremont Street from Wells to Taylor be moved from its current east side designation to the west side.)
6. DISCUSSION AND ACTION – Two-way traffic on 300 block of South Wacouta Avenue (NOTE: The traffic has been two-way since the start of the Wisconsin Street project. Staff would like the Committee's direction on whether or not to leave the traffic pattern as it is, or revert back to the pre-construction one-way traffic pattern.)
7. DISCUSSION AND ACTION – Archaeological work (NOTE: In recent conversations with the DOT, they will not adjust their archaeological/historical review limits or pay for any additional costs to do an archaeological and historical survey on areas outside of their previous limits. Vicki Twinde from MVAC estimated the cost to do the archaeological and historical survey on the additional areas to be \$4,000-5,000. The archaeological and historical survey is a TIF eligible expense and can be paid for through TIF. Staff will be seeking permission from the Committee to address the additional work through TIF funds.)
8. ADJOURN to the Villa Louis Boat Landing
9. RECONVENE at the Villa Louis Boat Landing
10. DISCUSSION AND ACTION – Improvements to the Villa Louis Boat Landing (NOTE: The Committee and staff will be touring the site, and discussing possible improvements to the landing, with a 2013 target date.)
