ITEMS TO BE DISCUSSED AND ACTED UPON:

4. DISCUSSION AND ACTION – Exemption Request from Intersection/Access Requirements

Judy Wall (NSP) is proposing a new curb cut for a driveway onto 131 North Prairie Street that will be within 50 feet of the intersection of Prairie and Louis Streets. It is estimated that the new driveway will be 35 feet from the radius, therefore she is requesting an exemption.

5. DISCUSSION AND ACTION – Proposed Lot Prices for the Woodridge Acres Subdivision
