REPEALING AND RECREATING CHAPTER 9.01 (OFFENSES AGAINST STATE LAWS SUBJECT TO FORFEITURE) OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF PRAIRIE DU CHIEN, CRAWFORD COUNTY, WISCONSIN

Purpose: The purpose of this Ordinance is to add the state statute against the illegal use of drones to the list of offenses which can be cited as a municipal violation.

The Common Council of the City of Prairie du Chien, Crawford County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section 1: That Chapter 9.01 (Offenses Against State Law Subject to Forfeiture) of the Municipal Code of the City of Prairie du Chien, Wisconsin be repealed and re-created to read as follows:

9.01 (OFFENSES AGAINST STATE LAWS SUBJECT TO FORFEITURE)

The following statutes following the prefix "9" defining offenses against the peace and good order of the State are adopted by reference to define offenses against the peace and good order of the City, provided the penalty for commission of such offenses hereunder shall be limited to a forfeiture imposed under Sec. 25.04 of this Code.

In addition to the penalty imposed under Section 25.04 of the Municipal Code of the City of Prairie du Chien, Crawford County, Wisconsin, any person, corporation, or entity that issues any worthless check or other worthless order for the payment of Real Estate Taxes, Personal Property Taxes, Special Assessments, Sewer and Water charges, or any other charge levied by the City of Prairie du Chien that by statute or ordinance can be placed on the tax roll, shall pay interest at the rate of 1% per month on the obligation owed for any month or part of a month that the check or order issued to pay said obligation(s) remains uncollected after the date of presentment of the worthless check or worthless order, plus the sum of \$25.00 for each worthless check or ordered issued.

Section 2: Any ordinance or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
