

**RESOLUTION 2015-41**

**RESOLUTION INDICATING THE WILLINGNESS OF THE CITY TO ANNEX THAT AREA  
OF THE TOWN OF BRIDGEPORT DESIGNATED FOR INCORPORATION**

**WHEREAS**, the town of Bridgeport, Crawford County, Wisconsin (“the Town”) filed a Petition to Incorporate the unincorporated territory in the Town with the Circuit Court on April 19<sup>th</sup> 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, a hearing shall be held on August 6<sup>th</sup> 2015 before the honorable James Czajkowski on the Petition to Incorporate; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town desires to incorporate the entirety of its 23.2 square miles, of which said proposed incorporated land would be contiguous with the City of Prairie du Chien (“the City”); and

**WHEREAS**, the City provides water and sewer service to a section of the Town, through a Sanitary District, under an agreement entered into on June 20<sup>th</sup> 2007 and set to expire on June 20<sup>th</sup> 2017, of which a reproduction of said agreement is attached to this resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, the City provides public safety services to the residents and businesses of the Town due to the contiguous boundary of the two entities; and

**WHEREAS**, the residents of both the Town and City share the benefits of several community activities and facilities, have natural boundaries, share a natural drainage basin, share contiguous soil conditions, have joint transportation facilities, are served jointly by the Prairie du Chien Area School District, and share in common social customs; and

**WHEREAS**, the City believes that it can provide the same level of public service to the residents of the Town without the necessity of incorporation; and

**WHEREAS**, the City believes it must act in the best interests of the residents it serves; and

**WHEREAS**, Wisconsin State Statute 66.0203 (6) (Annexation Resolution) reads as follows:

“Any municipality whose boundaries are contiguous to the territory may also file with the circuit court a certified copy of a resolution adopted by a two-thirds vote of the elected members of the governing body indicating a willingness to annex the territory designated in the incorporation petition. The resolution shall be filed at or prior to the hearing on the incorporation petition, or any adjournment granted for this purpose by the court.”

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Common Council of the City of Prairie du Chien, Crawford County, under the auspices of Wisconsin State Statute 66.0203 (6), that the City of Prairie du Chien indicates and expresses a willingness to annex the territory of the Town of Bridgeport so designated in the incorporation petition filed with the Circuit Court on April 19<sup>th</sup> 2015, and respectfully requests the Circuit Court, upon conducting a hearing on said incorporation petition, consider the willingness and desires of the City in any further matters relative to this matter.

## WATER AND SEWER AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made this 20th day of June, 2007, by and between the **City of Prairie du Chien**, Crawford County, Wisconsin, a Wisconsin municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as "**City**" and **Sanitary District No. 1 of the Town of Bridgeport**, Crawford County, Wisconsin, hereinafter referred to as "**District**".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties hereto each have the responsibility of providing an efficient means of distributing potable water and providing fire protection to its customers, and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto each have the responsibility of providing an orderly, efficient, and sanitary means of collecting, transporting, and disposing of sewage created by said customers, and

WHEREAS, the **City** has a complete waterworks utility which has been in operation for an extended period of time, and

WHEREAS, the **City** has a complete sewage collection and disposal system which has been in operation for extended period of time, and

WHEREAS, the **District** has constructed a water distribution system and hydrants within the **District** to provide water and fire protection for **District** residents and properties and has requested the **City** to provide it with a supply of water and pressure for its system, and

WHEREAS, the **District** has provided a sewage collection system within the **District** and has requested the **City** to accept and treat effluent from the **District's** collection system, and

WHEREAS, the **City** and the **District** desire to enter into an Agreement whereby the **City** will furnish water and pressure to the **District** and the **City** will accept and dispose of sewage effluent from the **District**.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the **City** agrees to furnish water and pressure to the **District** and accept, treat and dispose of sewage effluent from the **District** for a term and under the conditions as hereinafter set forth.

1. The term of this Agreement shall be for a period of ten (10) years commencing the 20th day of June, 2007, and ending the 20th day of June, 2017. Further, this Agreement shall be extended for an additional five (5) years from its termination date in the event neither party gives written notice to the other party of its intent to terminate this Agreement at least one (1) year prior to the end of the initial term. Further, this Agreement shall be extended for an additional five (5) year period if neither party gives written notice to the other of its intent to terminate this Agreement at least one (1) year prior to the end of the first five (5) year extension. All notices as herein required shall be given as follows:

at his/her then present address

2. The **District** herein agrees to pay to the **City** for the delivery of water and pressure to the **District** an amount(s) as set from time to time by the Public Service Commission for the State of Wisconsin. Said amount(s) to be paid to the **City** by the **District** on an annual basis payable in four (4) billing periods of three (3) months each, with a billing to be mailed by the **City** to the **District** in March, June, September, and December of each year. The first billing hereunder to be November 22, 2007. In addition, fees for water and pressure delivered hereunder shall be computed using the rates set forth from time to time by the Public Service Commission based on the volume of water delivered by the **City** to the **District** for each three (3) month period of this Agreement as measured by the master meter located at the southwest corner of the intersection of La Pointe Street and U.S. Highway 18, plus the total water readings of each water user as shown by the individual meters of each user receiving water from the **City** not flowing through nor measured by the master meter above referred to.

Further, for a period of ten (10) years from the effective date of this Agreement, the **District** shall not construct, install, operate, or maintain a separate facility for pumping water without a release by the **City** from this Agreement. It is contemplated that expansion within the **District** will be residential, industrial, and commercial of the type presently in the **District** and that the **City** will be able to handle said expansion for the ten (10) year period under normal expansion of its water supply system, which would be likely to occur. In the event the **District** considers hooking to its system a user of more than normal demand, the

**District** shall request permission from the **City** before extending its system to such user and/or prior to hooking said user to the system. Permission can only be denied by the **City** due to lack of capacity at the time of the request. In the event the **City** finds lack of capacity, the parties hereto agree to negotiate for the enlargement of the **City's** facility so as to allow the **City** to provide additional capacity. Such additional costs associated with enlargement of the **City's** facility may be re-covered by contribution from the **District**, by adjustment of rates to cover the additional cost over a period of years, or by a combination of these methods. Also, included as a possible prerequisite to expansion of the **City** facility would be an agreement that the **District** shall not construct, install, or maintain a separate facility for pumping water for a period of time agreeable to the **City** in order to assure the **City** a return on the additional investment for the period of years required to offset the additional investment. The final decision as to the method or methods above set forth to be used to cover additional costs for construction of any additional facilities arising out of a request as above set forth by the **District** shall be arrived at through negotiations between the parties. The **City**, however, shall not be required to accept any proposal made by the **District** as to a suitable method to cover the cost of construction of any additional capacity to the **City's** water supply system. In the event **City** at its sole discretion determines that negotiations with the **District** will not result in a suitable method by which funding of the construction of additional capacity to the **City's** water supply system can be achieved, the **City** shall so notify the **District** in writing through the Office of the Town Clerk for the Town of Bridgeport at his/her then present address when such an agreement cannot be reached and this Agreement shall terminate twenty-four (24) months from date of such notice. Thereafter, neither party shall have any obligation to the other under this Agreement and further neither party hereto shall have any cause of action against the other based on this Agreement for the cancellation of same.

3. The **District** hereby agrees to pay to **City** for accepting, treating, and disposing of sewage effluent generated within the **District**, that is acceptable pursuant to the rules and regulations of the **City** and any amendments thereto, an amount(s) set by the City of Prairie du Chien Sewer Rate Ordinance now in effect or as amended from time to time. Said amount(s) to be paid by the **District** to the **City** on an annual basis payable in four (4) billing periods of three (3) month intervals with a billing to be mailed by the **City** to the **District** in March, June, September, and December of each year. The first billing hereunder to be November 22, 2007.

Further, for a period of ten (10) years from the effective date of this Agreement, the **District** shall not construct, install, operate, or maintain a separate facility for the treatment of its waste water or sewage without a release by the **City** from this Agreement. It is contemplated that expansion within the **District** will be residential, industrial, and commercial of the type presently in the **District** and that the **City** will be able to handle said expansion for the next ten (10) year period under normal expansion of its disposal facility, which would be likely to occur. In the event the **District** considers hooking to its system

a user of more than normal demand, the **District** shall request permission from the **City** before extending its system to such user and/or prior to hooking said user to the system. Permission can only be denied by the **City** due to lack of capacity at the time of the request. In the event the **City** finds lack of capacity, the parties hereto agree to negotiate for the enlargement of the **City's** facility so as to allow the **City** to provide additional capacity. Such additional costs associated with enlargement of the **City's** facility may be re-covered by contribution from the **District**, by adjustment of rates to cover the additional cost over a period of years, or by a combination of these methods. Also, included as a possible prerequisite to expansion of the **City** facility would be an agreement that the **District** shall not construct, install, or maintain a separate facility for the treatment of its waste water or sewage for a period of time agreeable to the **City** in order to assure the **City** a return on the additional investment for the period of years required to offset the additional investment. The final decision as to the method or methods above set forth to be used to cover additional costs for construction of any additional facilities arising out of a request as above set forth by the **District** shall be arrived at through negotiations between the parties. The **City**, however, shall not be required to accept any proposal made by the **District** as to a suitable method to cover the cost of construction of any additional capacity to the **City's** wastewater treatment facility. In the event **City** at its sole discretion determines that negotiations with the **District** will not result in a suitable method by which funding of the construction of additional capacity to the **City's** wastewater treatment facility can be achieved, the **City** shall so notify the **District** in writing through the Office of the Town Clerk for the Town of Bridgeport at his/her then present address when such an agreement cannot be reached and this Agreement shall terminate twenty-four (24) months from date of such notice. Thereafter, neither party shall have any obligation to the other under this Agreement and further neither party hereto shall have any cause of action against the other based on this Agreement or the cancellation of same.

4. The parties hereto will forthwith jointly file this Agreement with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin. The **City** agrees to file a request with the Public Service Commission requesting the Public Service Commission to file charges as set forth below as a part of its rate schedule. The **District** agrees to support this request. The **District** agrees that it will jointly request a rate hearing for the **District** if and when the **City** determines to file such a request. The **District** further agrees in such an event to cooperate with the **City** in requested changes. It is agreed that rate increases or decreases granted to the **City** shall be proportionately applied to the **District** rates. All Public Service Commission rules and regulations now in effect or in the future established shall apply to the **District** insofar as such rules and regulations affect the operation of the **District**. As an exception to this, rules and regulations applying to the type of materials or equipment shall not govern the **District**. This exception is made because the **District** has installed PVC pipe instead of ductile iron pipe for some of its mains and may use hydrants or other equipment different from that of the **City**.

It is further hereby agreed that the charges to be made for the water furnished by the **City** to the **District** and to be filed with the Public Service Commission as above provided shall be made on a volume basis at a rate of \$0.79 per 100 cubic feet. Due dates and penalty charges for failure to pay on time shall be the same as applied to other users of the Prairie du Chien water works.

5. It is agreed and understood by the parties hereto that some **City** users are presently connected along the transmission line that runs from the Burlington, Northern, and Sante Fe Railroad tracks along La Pointe Street east to Marquette Road, the **City** may connect additional users from to time to this line. The **City's** use of said line, however, is limited to 40% of the volume of this line. Maintenance of said line will be shared by the **District** and the **City** at the ratio of 60% for the **District** and 40% for the **City**. In the event said line is required to be relocated as a result of road construction associated with the Highway 18 bypass, the cost of relocation shall be 60% by the **District** and 40% by the **City**.

6. Each party hereto shall keep accurate books, records, and accounts of costs, expenses, expenditures, and receipts as they pertain to this Agreement. Upon reasonable notice, either party shall be entitled to examine any and all books and/or records of the other.

7. The **City** is presently disposing of a portion of its bio-solids within the Town of Bridgeport and said disposal shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Department of Natural Resources, now in effect or hereafter adopted.

8. The **District** agrees at its sole cost and expense to have its master meter independently tested at least once a year by a company acceptable to the **City** and furnish to the **City** a copy of any test and report. The **District** likewise agrees to maintain a testing procedure for the meters of each individual user receiving water that is not measured by the master meter. In addition to the **District** test, the **City** may at its sole option also inspect and test the master meter and the individual meters referred to above at any time. In the event any of the tests indicate inaccuracies in the measuring by the master meter or any of the other meters, the **District** hereby agrees to forthwith at its sole cost and expense correct same.

9. The **District** agrees to operate its sewage utility subject to the rules and regulations of the City of Prairie du Chien Sewer Utility regulating effluent. The **District** shall adopt the present **City** ordinances regulating the discharge of effluent by **District** users into the system and further the **District** agrees to adopt in the future any changes to said ordinances. The **City** may reject effluent from the **District** if it would be subject to rejection under the **City** rules and require pretreatment if pretreatment would be required under **City** rules. Any user in the **District** which would be required to install and operate

sampling equipment under **City** rules shall be required by the **District** to install and operate sampling equipment. For any user required to install sampling equipment, the **District** shall obtain the necessary easements to allow the **City** as well as the **District** to enter any such premises in order to monitor, test, or inspect the sampling equipment. The **District** agrees at its sole cost and expense to have its master meter located at the southwest corner of the intersection of La Pointe Street and U.S. Highway 18 independently tested twice each year by a company acceptable to the **City** and furnish to the **City** a copy of any test and/or report. The **District** commits itself as its sole cost and expense to provide an above ground display so that **City** personnel can determine whether the master meter is operating properly. The **City** is hereby granted the right and authority to inspect the **District's** system at anytime to ascertain that the **District** and its users are operating in accordance with the rules and regulations of the **City**. In addition, to the **District** test, **City** may at its option also inspect and test the master meter. If a **District** test or a **City** test discloses measuring defects in the master meter, the **District** agrees to repair and correct same immediately at its sole cost and expense.

10. This Agreement is binding upon the parties hereto, their successors and assigns.

11. This Agreement has been authorized by the Common Council for the City of Prairie du Chien and the Board of Commissioners of Sanitary District No. 1 of the Town of Bridgeport.


12. **District** agrees that all maintenance of the **District** mains and other equipment shall be at the **District's** sole cost and expense and that the **City** has no responsibility or obligation to maintain or contribute to the maintenance of same.

13. The boundaries of the area to which this Agreement applies and to which service shall be extended by the **City** is set forth on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.







## Incorporation Description for Bridgeport

Crawford County, Wisconsin

The proposed incorporation includes all of the Town of Bridgeport, approximately located in Section 31, T7N, R5W, part of Section 6 and 7, T6N, R5W, part of Section 32 and Sections 33, 34, 35, and 36, T7N, R6W, part of Sections 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 11, 12, 14, 15, 16, 17, and 18 and Sections 1, 2, 3, 9, and 10, T6N, R6W, part of Sections 35 and 36, T7N, R7W, part of Sections 1, 2, 11, 13, and 14 and Section 12, T6N, R7W, and part of Farm Lots 39, 40, 41, 42, and 43 of the Private Land Claims at Prairie du Chien, Crawford County, Wisconsin and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a point in the Western boundary line of the State of Wisconsin, said point being located in the middle of the Main Channel of the Mississippi River opposite the mouth of the Wisconsin River;

Thence easterly along the middle of the Main Channel of the Wisconsin River to a point on the East line of Section 6, T6N, R5W;

Thence north along the East line of Section 6, T6N, R5W to the Northeast corner thereof;

Thence north along the East line of Section 31, T7N, R5W to the Northeast corner thereof;

Thence west along the North line of Section 31, T7N, R5W to the Northwest corner thereof;

Thence west along the North line of Section 36, T7N, R6W to the Northwest corner thereof;

Thence west along the North line of Section 35, T7N, R6W to the Northwest corner thereof;

Thence west along the North line of Section 34, T7N, R6W to the Northwest corner thereof;

Thence west along the North line of Section 33, T7N, R6W to the Northwest corner thereof;

Thence west along the North line of Section 32, T7N, R6W to the Northwest corner thereof;

Thence south along the West line of Section 32, T7N, R6W to the West Quarter (W  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) Corner of Section 32, T7N, R6W;

Thence east along the North line of Government Lot 1 of Section 32, T7N, R6W to the Northeast corner thereof;

Thence south along the East line of Government Lot 1 of Section 32, T7N, R6W to the North line of Government Lot 2 of Section 32, T7N, R6W;

Thence east along the North line of Government Lot 2 of Section 32, T7N, R6W to the Northeast corner thereof;

Thence south along the East line of Government Lot 2 of Section 32, T7N, R6W to a point 12.5 rods north of the South line of Section 32, T7N, R6W;

Thence east to a point 30 rods 6 feet east of a line running north from the Northwest corner of the NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 5, T6N, R6W;

Thence south 12.5 rods to a point on the North line of said NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 5, T6N, R6W, said point being 30 rods 6 feet east of the northwest corner of the NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 5, T6N, R6W;

Thence east to the Northeast corner of Section 5, T6N, R6W;

N78°48'45"W 785 feet, more or less, from the intersection of said Southerly line with the centerline of the main track of the Burlington Northern Railroad;

Thence running northwesterly, along a straight line, making an angle of 43°05' to the right with the Southerly line of Farm Lot 43 produced westerly a distance of 2400 feet, more or less, to the Southerly line of the land owned by the Chicago, Milwaukee & St. Paul Railway Company and used as a sand pit;

Thence westerly, on a straight line, making an angle of 130° with the last described course produced westerly (said angle being the SW angle) to its intersection with the Westerly line of said Lot 43;

Thence N 25°52'49" W to the Northwest corner of Farm Lot 43;

Thence N 23°00'00" W 867.90 feet, more or less, to the Northwest corner of Farm Lot 42;

Thence N 25°50'12" W 895.23 feet, more or less, to the Northwest corner of Farm Lot 41;

Thence N 25°00'00" W 531.14 feet, more or less, along the Westerly line of Farm Lot 40 to the centerline of La Pointe Street extended;

Thence westerly along the Westerly extension of the centerline of La Pointe Street to the East Channel of the Mississippi River;

Thence northerly along the East Channel of the Mississippi River to the North line of Section 36, T7N, R7W;

Thence west along the North line of Section 36, T7N, R7W to the Northwest corner thereof;

Thence west along the North line of Section 35, T7N, R7W to the middle of the Main Channel of the Mississippi River and the Western boundary of the State of Wisconsin;

Thence southerly along the middle of the Main Channel of the Mississippi River and the Western boundary of the State of Wisconsin to the mouth of the Wisconsin River and the point of beginning.

3. A legal description of the territory proposed to be incorporated is appended to this Petition as Exhibit A, and incorporated herein by reference.

4. The territory proposed to be incorporated contains 23.2 square miles of land more or less.

5. A scale map, reasonably showing the boundaries of the territory described in the legal description, is appended to this Petition as Exhibit B, and incorporated herein by reference.

6. The current resident population of the territory to be incorporated as determined by the definition given in Wis. Stat. § 66.0201(2)(dm.) is 990.

7. The area proposed to be incorporated as a metropolitan village meets the standards and requirements of Wis. Stat. § 66.0207 (1) and (2) in that:

- (1) The territory of the proposed Village is reasonably homogeneous and compact, taking into consideration natural boundaries, natural drainage basin, soil conditions, present and potential transportation facilities, previous political boundaries, boundaries of school districts, shopping and social customs. Further the area proposed to be incorporated contains a reasonably developed

community center, which includes retail stores, churches, restaurants, recreational facilities and other businesses and activities that evidence a community center and community activity.

- (2) The territory beyond the most densely populated square mile as specified in Wis. Stat. § 66.0205(3) has the potential for residential or other urban land use development on a substantial scale within the next 3 years.
- (3) The present and potential sources of tax revenue is sufficient to defray the anticipated cost of governmental services at a local tax rate which compares favorably with the tax rate in a similar area for the same level of services.
- (4) The level of services, including police and fire protection, which is desired or needed by the residents of the unincorporated territory proposed for incorporation is comparable to the level of services offered by the City of Prairie Du Chien.






